

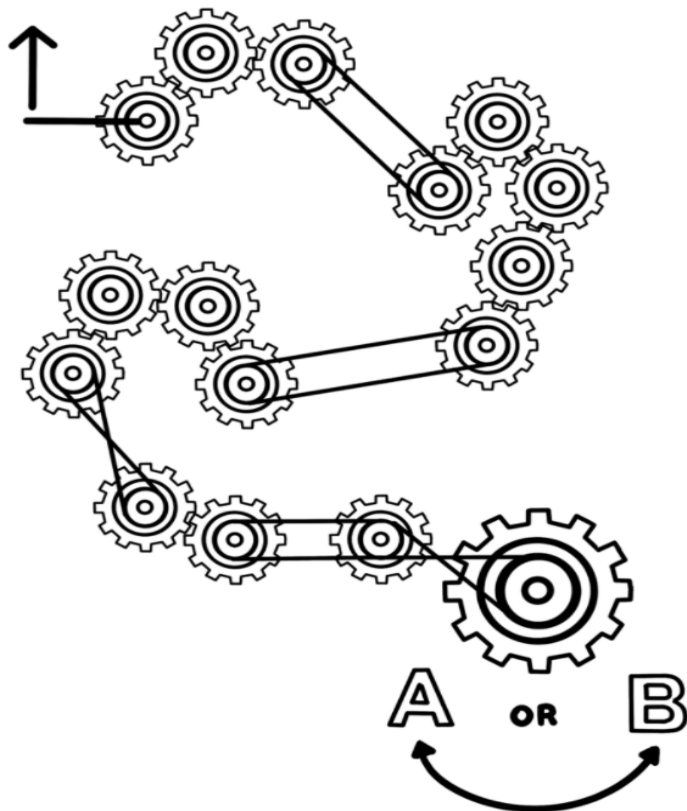

## Which direction?

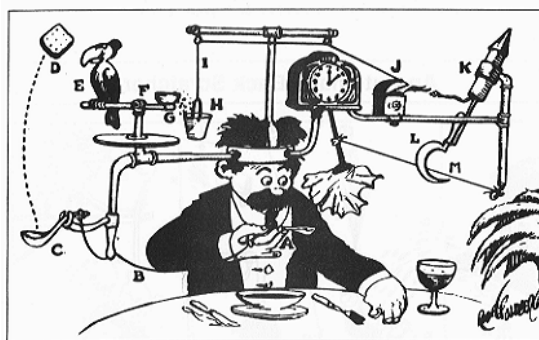
Which way does the bottom cog turn when the first cog is turned clockwise?

2 numbers correct but in the wrong place

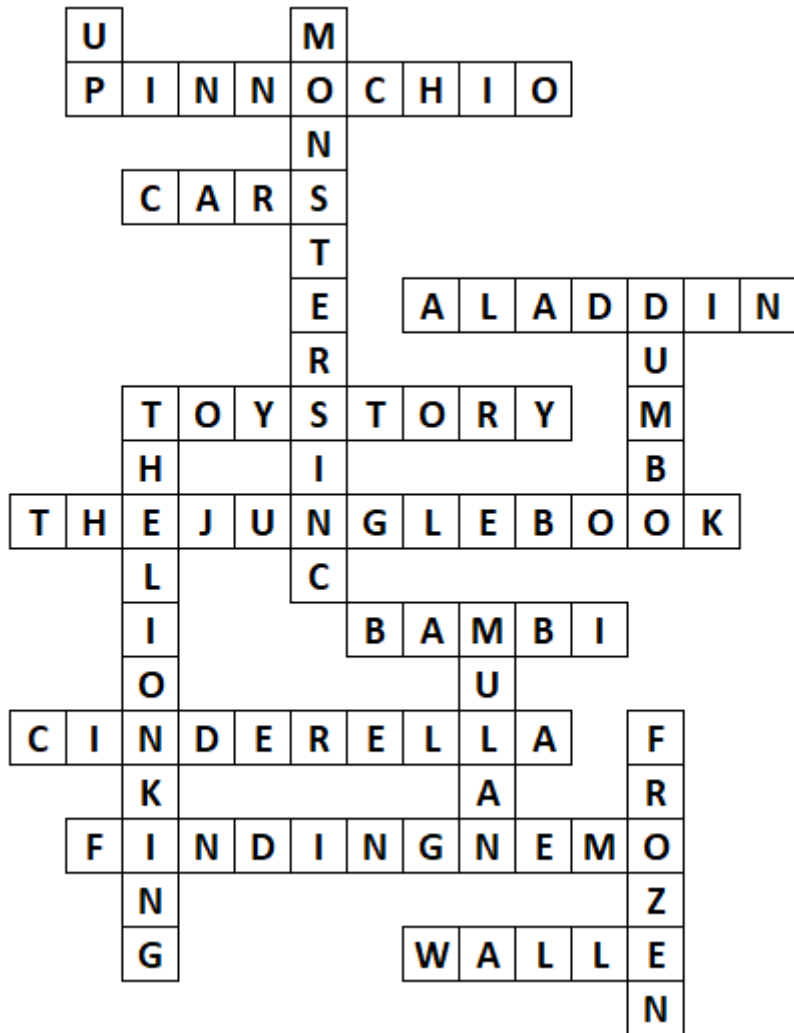
1 number correct but in the wrong place
