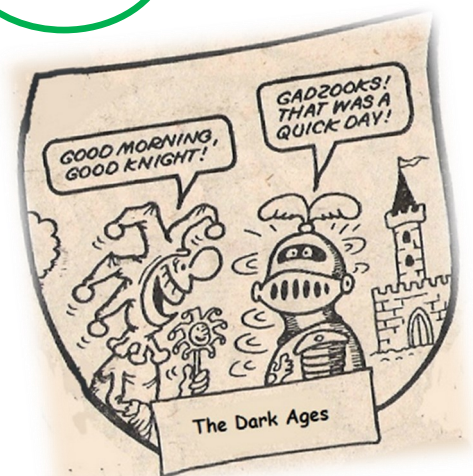
Minesweeper!

The Romans sometimes used stale urine as mouthwash!

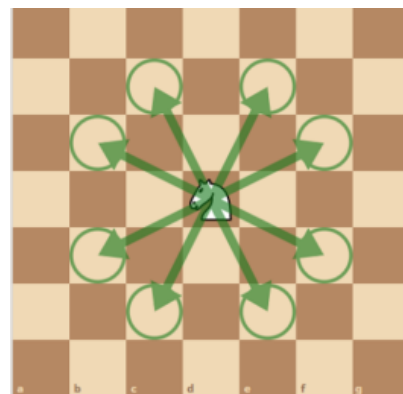


Knight's Tour
